Mr. Lauricella was born in Lepari, Italy, before immigrating to the United States he lived in New York until 1997 when he moved to Belford. He served Honorably in the Army during WWII he was stationed in New Guinea and the Philippines.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus Vincent Lombardi Council, VFW 2179 Port Monmouth, and American Legion Post 338

He went to the Pratt Institute and later became an accomplished Commercial Artist.
